TV song master Mitch Miller died last week at the age of 99. While in high school, I worked with **Mitch Miller** at a local Ukrop's. **James Brown** worked there, too. But, as you might suspect, it wasn't *that* Mitch Miller, nor was it the soul singer James Brown... just two guys with the same names as famous people. (**Bob Lanier** was a great NBA basketball star in the '70's, but he's not to be confused with the Bob Lanier who is one of the fine deacons of our church.)

I recently read an article about the experiences of ordinary people who bear the same names as celebrities or famous politicians. Sometimes it's fun for them, and at other times it's awkward and a hassle.

Did you know that you and I have the same name? It's the name that defines who we are and what we are going to be. The name **Jesus Christ** changes your identity and pulls you out of a dead world to make you alive to the light and love of God!

His name makes us one with each other in powerful ways. Because of Him, we are all family!
