Blessed in Doing Nothing

Some people enjoy vacations filled with lots of travel and activities. Since my typical workday is filled with going, doing, and traveling about, I rather prefer a week of inactivity instead. "To each his own," as they say.

Last week, Debbie and I stayed in a cottage by a lake and were very intentional about “doing nothing.” Oh, we took boat rides, swam a little, read, and took walks, but otherwise we sat by the lake and enjoyed the view. My watch came off in an attempt to abandon the tyranny of “the clock.” At first, doing nothing is difficult; I’m so wired to *do things*, it’s an adjustment.
