Studies show that a person who performs a particular action for *21 days in a row* is extremely likely to retain that activity as a habit. Habits are powerful and useful. They save us time, money, and energy. Of course, they can also bog us down in useless, harmful acts, too.

Last Sunday, I made a point to remind myself: *Belinda Kunkel is going to read a scripture right after the choir special and before the message.
