As the night skies lit up, a small plane materialized out of the darkness, seemingly out of nowhere, and landed. Slim and his friend watched in amazement as Franklin Graham, son of the famous evangelist, Billy Graham, stepped off the plane. The pilot had been flying Franklin back to school in Texas when the electrical system of the plane shut down, leaving them stranded in the night without lights or radio or any means of guidance.
